



# Medications

1. If your child will be receiving medication at school, a D20 medication form **MUST** be filled out and signed by you as well as the medical provider with prescriptive authority.
2. **PARENTS** must transport all medication to and from school. No medication will be given to the child to take home.
3. Disciplinary action may also occur if your child is found with medication in his/her backpack or is taking medication unsupervised. ( **This includes over the counter medications**)
4. Prescription and/or non-prescription medication such as Tylenol, cough drops, vitamins, ect are prohibited at school. ( **The only permitted lozenge is HALLS BREEZERS** )
5. **THE EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE** applies to students with **severe allergies** who have permission to self-carry and self-administer medications. Asthma,; inhaler OR Epi-pen for life threatening allergies. If the student mishandles the inhaler and/or safety of the other students is at risk, the school nurse/administrator will call the parent.
6. All prescription and non-prescription medication must be in the original container with correct dosage and directions on label when brought to the health room by the parent.
